Supervisor Prendergast opened the Public Hearing at 7:00 PM for Local Law # 1 of 2018.

<u>Approval of Minutes:</u> Motion was made by Glenn Quackenbush, seconded by Brian Murphy to approve the June 13th, 2018 minutes as presented. Motion was carried.

Water District #1 Extension: Supervisor Prendergast reported the following on WD #1 Ext: June 6, (4) bids were received which all exceeded the Map, Plan & Report amount of \$709,000.00 At this time Engineer, Jeremy Delyser (Clark-Patterson-Lee) has requested from USDA (Rural Development) an additional \$323,000 in funding to complete this project. At the time of the meeting we hadn't received notification of the request and we don't know how much of the additional money requested will be loan/grant. Prendergast continued that there are several steps to be taken for this project to continue. Due to the fact the cost will go above the state threshold, approval from the State Comptroller will be required. Residents from the proposed district had several questions regarding the required steps. Supervisor Prendergast didn't answer certain questions and didn't want to state any wrong information. It was also requested by a resident, Patricia Hilberer to have the town attorney be present at the next meeting, (Ultimately it will be a board decision to have the attorney present.) Prendergast stated we hope to have more information at the August 8th, 2018 meeting.

Water District # 5: (Earls Hill Road). Jim Colizzi reported that he had approximately 51% of the residents in this proposed district signing the petition. He will continue to acquire signatures and report back to the town board. If approved, this district will also need the State Comptrollers approval.

Old Business:

Generator: Councilman Harper stated that he is waiting for proposals from Dailey Electric and Sloth Electric. He will provide the Quik Solar proposal to make sure all proposals are equal.

New Business:

The 2018 Finger Lakes Railway "PILOT" Distribution check was received in the amount of \$287.89.

Nine-Element Watershed Plan: Mark Venuti is in pursuit of funding for the Nine Element (9E) plan. After board discussion it was decided to approve supporting the plan. Grant Downs explained that the Town of Geneva will be the Lead Agency in this early investigation into funding for solutions of (controlling runoff and improving water quality). Going forward support of the 9E plan will help secure a grant. Resolution below.

<u>Highway:</u> Jeff Mann reported that the old excavator brought in \$33K. The new loader will cost \$33,635.49 with a trade in of \$125,00.00, 2018 K-Model Loader thru (NJPA) Five Start.
